

ZGM Resumption of On-site Services Brief

Resumption of On-Site Services

- Due to Covid restrictions, a maximum of 50 people are allowed on-site for a service (excluding support/ministry staff).
- Cells will be grouped and scheduled to come down on-site on a rotation basis, beginning 4th Oct.
- **Beginning 4th October 2020, service will be shifted to start at 11.30am. This allows for sufficient interval between the Chinese service held earlier.**
- If you intend to bring a friend, please inform Elder Lawrence or Joseph 1 week before service, so we can schedule him or her in.
- Cells *not* on-site will be able to live stream the service at 11.30am. More details on the livestream to follow.

Cell Groupings

- Cell groupings and scheduled dates (till end Nov) are as follows. Group 1 is scheduled for *Oct 4*, Group 2 for *Oct 11*, Group 3 for *Oct 18* and so forth.
- **Members are advised not to come down on an unscheduled date, as you may be denied entry due to lack of space.**

On-site Procedures

When arriving at ZGM, please take note of the following procedures:

- Maintain social distancing at the lift and when queuing to enter ZGM.
- Upon arrival at ZGM, perform SafeEntry procedures by first sanitizing your hands. Then, perform check-in and have your temperature screened.*
- Thereafter, head straight to the sanctuary through its main entrance.
- Upon entering the sanctuary, deposit your tithes and offering in an offering box on your right.
- Similarly, pick up Holy Communion cups from a table on your right (1st Sun of the month).
- Proceed to find a seat. Seats are free-seating and will be spaced 1m apart.
- After service, leave the sanctuary in a quiet and orderly fashion via the same main entrance.
- Be reminded to check-out at the exit before leaving ZGM.

***Please refrain from coming on-site if you are unwell. Congregants who are unwell may be denied entry.**

Service Rules

- Do maintain 1-meter social distancing (including children)
- Do keep your masks on at all times (including children six years of age and above)
- Please refrain from singing during worship (singing in your hearts encouraged!)
- Please refrain from consuming food on premise
- Please refrain from interacting with others before, during and after service
- Please take your leave from the premises immediately after service

Service Flow

Service commences 11.30am and is expected to end by 12.45pm

- Pre-recorded worship
- Communion (1st Sun of the month only)
- Announcements
- Live sermon
- Close

Communion

- Communion will continue to be held on the 1st Sunday of each month.
- On-site congregants must self-collect communion cups upon entering the sanctuary, as there will be no distribution during service. The cups will be found to your right when entering the sanctuary.
- When leaving the sanctuary, drop off your spent communion cups in bins placed at the exit.
- Live stream congregants should prepare your own communion elements to participate in communion.

Tithes and Offerings

- Tithes and offerings must be self-deposited in the offering box when entering (or exiting) the sanctuary, as there will be no collection during service. The offering box will be found on your right when entering the sanctuary.
- Alternatively, you may continue to give your tithes and offerings online or by cheque, as detailed in the next slide.

Example: *ETWongBeeLian*, for a tithe from English congregant Wong Bee Lian. You need not give your name if it is an offering.
Contributions without a code will go to offering.
